

Appeldoorn Trail Hike

The Southwest Michigan Council invites you and your Scouts to come take a hike!

The Appeldoorn is a five mile trail that snakes its way through Rota-Kiwan Scout Reservation and parts of Al Sabo Land Preserve. This is an easy hike, designed to introduce your Scouts to the beauty of all seasons. Walk often and you can be one of the few to earn a variety of pins and rockers.

On your first five mile hike you will earn this belt patch and the appropriate season pin.



Summer season pin

- *June
- *July
- *August



Winter season pin

- *December
- *January
- *February



Spring season pin

- *March
- *April
- *May



Fall season pin

- *September
- *October
- *November



After you have completed all seasons, on your fifth hike you will earn this boot.



Keep walking and after another five times (each season plus one) you will earn this



Keep walking and after a total of ten times you will earn this rocker.

To participate, at least two weeks prior please call the Southwest Michigan Council office at 269-343-4687 and tell us when you would like to take your hike. Once you have completed your hike, stop by the Southwest Michigan Council Scout Shop and purchase your belt patch and appropriate pins.
