- Flashlight with red lens or covered with red cellophane
- First Aid Kit (please refer to the Boy Scout Handbook for requirements)

During the search and rescue mission, patrols will be given a snack.
Estimated time of mission completion is 1:00AM

Other weekend activities:

Friday...OA campfire and call out ceremony.

Saturday...In addition to the search and rescue mission, Scouts have the opportunity in participating in a cooking contest. Scouts will be asked to prepare their favorite campfire recipe with the winners being judged on presentation as well as taste.

Cost and Check-In: \$15.00 per Scout or Scouter and includes Sunday breakfast, a snack, camping and a patch. Check-in begins Friday at 6PM. Saturday check-in is available from 8AM until 12:00PM.
